

## GC DIOCESAN RESOLUTIONS

A161 (1, Suppl. #1, 8) Urges dioceses, congregations and worshipping communities to include accurate and comprehensive HIV and AIDs prevention in youth education programs; further urges congregations to propose to parents how to discuss sex with their children.

B003 (1, Suppl #2, 3) Proposes assistance to dioceses in their camping ministries through development of resources through the coming triennium

C064 (2, Daily, 11) Endorses the Earth Charter and encourages dioceses to take action “consonant with the charter” locally, nationally and internationally.

D014 (2, Daily, 12) Urges diocesan commissions to encourage each congregation to educate about public environmental decisions that would adversely impact the most vulnerable, and to educate for an environmentally just decision.

A172 (3, Daily, 4) Directing the Secretary of each diocesan convention to forward copies of the journals of each convention together with other stuff either electronically or on paper to the Archives of the Church.

A082 (3, Daily, 8) Adopts the Charter for Lifelong Christian Formation, and A083 (3 Daily 9) all dioceses are “strongly encouraged” to formulate a strategy for Lifelong Christian Formation.

C071 (3, Suppl. #1, 3) Congregations to undertake discussions within the parish on the issue of health care coverage in the United States.

D038 (3, Suppl.#1, 3) Achieving a strategic vision for reaching Latinos/Hispanics

A163 (3, Suppl.#1, 10) Diocesan staff and all active clergy are “strongly encouraged” to take a web-based self-directed tutorial on HIV/AIDs.

A055 (4, Daily, 1) Standing Committee members can now sign documents in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.

A081 (5, Daily, 6) Dioceses and congregations are to make reasonable accommodation for full participation of staff and volunteers with disabilities who attend conferences or meetings on behalf of the Church.

A138 (5, Daily, 6) Mandatory Lay Employee Pension System --- see attached

A177 (7, Daily, 5) Denominational Health Plan-----see attached

D063 (6, Suppl.#1, 6) Dioceses to review emergency preparedness plans for dealing with pandemic diseases. Congregations to seek information on readiness for and instructions regarding pandemic diseases and “moral principles regarding distribution of resources in health emergencies”.

A142 (7, Suppl.#3, 7 ) Dioceses receive or review anti-racism training/ develop programs

A037 (10, Consent, 18) Pray for the wall around Bethlehem to come down, particularly during Advent and Christmas

A078 (10, Consent, 26) Every congregation is encouraged to raise awareness of recovery issues in a way suited to the particular congregation

B025 (9, Consent, 10) Dioceses are urged to encourage every congregation to develop a partnership with a local public school, and urges every Episcopalian to give 40 hours per year in support of public education

A143 (9, Consent, 10-11) Dioceses urged to extend (continue) the study of participation by Episcopalians in slavery, and the economic benefits of slavery, schedule a Day of Repentance, and report to the 2012 and 2015 General Conventions

D095 (9, Consent, 13) Dioceses and congregations are asked to focus on ways to minister to those in prison or returning to the community, and their families and victims.

C080 (9, Consent, 14) Develop ways to fully realize the Ministry of the Baptized

A166 (8, Consent, 5) Urges all dioceses and congregations to establish parental leave policies equally for clergy and laity for both birth and adoption “consistent with local employment laws and generous industry standards”

A159 (6, Consent, 3) Urges dioceses and congregations to provide full, complete and accurate information to all, especially young people, about HIV/AIDs and prevention of sexually transmitted diseases

D011 (6, Consent, 3) Calls on dioceses and congregations to become informed on the laws of states and the policies of health care institutions regarding decisions at the end of life “and regarding medical futility”.
